EVALUATE YOUR MINDSET



indset plays a pivotal role in our lives. It dictates the way we think of the world, our relationships, professions, and ultimately our life outcomes. Evaluating your mindset involves introspection and self-reflection to gain insight into your thoughts, beliefs, and attitudes.

You may have heard of Stanford researcher and professor Carol Dweck's concept of "growth" and "fixed" mindsets. A growth mindset describes the way we view challenges. If someone has a growth mindset, they recognize that their skill sets and abilities are capable of improvement and are always evolving. Individuals with a "growth mindset" see failures as opportunities for development and improvement; making them more likely to take leaps of faith and make bold moves in their relationships, careers, and other areas of their lives.

Those with a "fixed mindset" have the expectation that their talents and skills are innate, and

therefore, unchangeable. For example, if someone gives a work presentation and makes a mistake while speaking, they may make the determination that public speaking isn't a skill set of theirs and turn down future opportunities to speak because they "just don't have that skill".

Definition of Passion:

What is your purpose on this earth? Is it to fund missions that glorify God? What about using your gift for speaking to minister to the youth of today?


STEP 5 TAKE AGTION
